Transy Supports *Collins Classic*

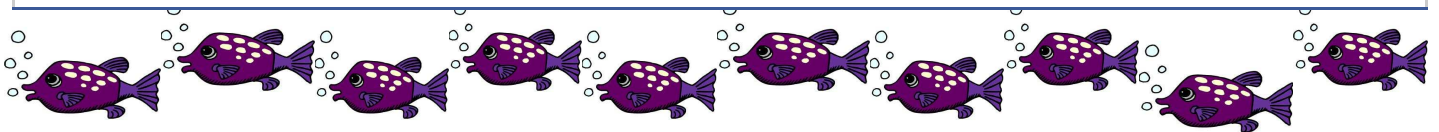
